

## **CADS SCHOOLING SHOW CHAMPIONSHIP RULES AND REQUIREMENTS**

The following divisions will be offered:

- 1 Intro (test ridden will be Intro B)
- 2 Training Level (test ridden will be Training 4)
- 3 First Level (test ridden will be First Level 4)
- 4 Second Level (test ridden will be Second Level 4)

The show is open to Young Rider, Adult Amateur, and Open Division CADS members. Riders must be members of CADS before their first qualifying ride. Eligible riders must have received a ribbon at a regular CADS schooling show for the current show season and must have completed his or her volunteer hours (8-hours total).

Only the same horse/rider combination is eligible for the championship show. No substitution of horse or rider is permitted.

Only the qualified rider may school the horse while on the show grounds, including the warm up ring.

A horse may qualify with two different riders. However, the riders must be showing in different divisions in the championship show.

A horse/rider combination who qualified in more than one division must compete at the higher level in the championship show.

H.C. must be marked on all schooling show entry forms if you are just trying out a higher level to not get bumped up to that higher level for the championship show.

All tests must be ridden from memory.

Whips will not be permitted.

Horses must be braided for the championship show and formal attire is requested.

Ten placings will be awarded for each division.
